PSHE

Our PSHE unit is 'Me and my relationships'. This unit focuses on feelings, how to be a good friend and our classroom rules.

RE

In RE the unit we will be exploring is 'Why do Christians call God 'creator?' It is the intention of this unit to help children to understand that most Christians believe God created the world and that the Bible tells the overarching account of God's creation and plan.

Science

Our science focus is *Animals including humans*. The children will be identifying, naming, describing and comparing a variety of common animals. We will also look at ourselves. This will involve naming our body parts and saying which part of the body is associated with each sense.

DT

Our design and technology unit is 'structures' and the children will be exploring the stability of structures and making a stable pencil pot for a specific user.

PE

Our PE days this half term are Tuesdays and Fridays
On Tuesday in PE our unit is gymnastics and we will be developing our shape and travel skills. On Friday, we will be focusing on the core skills of footwork and balance in *Real PE*.

Computing

In computing we will begin with online safety. The children will learn how to safely use the internet and discuss what the internet is and how it can be used.

History

Our history unit is 'How am I making History?' The children will be looking at and creating timelines about themselves and exploring their own memories and past using the language of 'before' and 'after'.

Music

In this unit, the children will explore keeping the pulse together through music and movement, by exploring their favourite things. The children will learn to recognise and understand the difference between pulse and rhythm through listening and performing.

Maths

Our Maths units this half term are:
- Place value
- Addition and subtraction

This half term's KIRF is to *recite the number names in order to 50 and beyond*

English

In English the children will begin by writing their own 'All About Me' fact book. They will then be using the text 'Meerkat Mail' to write postcards. Finally, they will be writing a setting description using the text 'The Squirrels who Squabbled' as inspiration.

Our whole class reads are books from the 'Top 100 Recommended Reads for Year 1'
