French

In French, we will learn to develop conversational skills via some new topics: transport, direction, and movement. We will continue to focus on introducing and rehearsing key vocabulary.

PSHE Our unit is 'The People we Share our World With'. As part of this unit, we will be thinking about some of the ways in which people are different to each other (including ethnicity, gender, religious beliefs, customs and festivals); We will be reflecting on the word *respect* and demonstrate ways of showing respect to others' differences. We will also be discussing things, such as how we can find solutions to situations where people don't agree.

RE Our new unit is called: What did Jesus say about God's Kingdom and why it is 'good news'? The children will explore how Jesus taught that God's Kingdom is the rule of God on earth and that Christians are citizens of that Kingdom. During this unit, children will explore what this might mean, looking at Jesus as ruler of this Kingdom, how it operates and how its citizens – Christians – might live. They will consider how this might be good news for Christians and how it may influence their actions.

Science Our new topic is Living things and their habitats. The children will explore a variety of ways to identify, sort, group and classify living things. They will learn how animals are split into 'vertebrates' and 'invertebrates' and begin to consider the differences between living things within these classifications. They will use and create classification keys.

DT

Our focus this half term is on Design and Technology. We shall be identifying electrical products and the children will create a functioning torch before look at key design improvements in the history of the automobile, culminating in designing their own mechanical car.

PE

In PE we will be focussing on our Orienteering skills. We will explore orienteering skills with the children. The children will also continue with their forest school sessions as before half term. **Our PE day is Wednesday.**

Computing In computing we will be looking at collaborative learning. The children will be exploring a range of collaborative tools; such as, sharing documents, slide presentations, creating forms and exporting data to spreadsheets.

Geography

We will investigate the key question: Where does our food come from? The children will explain which food has a negative impact of food production and how we can change that. We will learn about trading responsibly and how food imports can be both helpful and harmful.

Music Our unit this half term is 'Rock and Roll!' As part of this unit, we will be learning to perform the hand jive hand actions in sequence and in time with the music. We will develop our skills in singing in tune and performing our actions in time. We will then work up to playing the notes of the walking bass in the correct sequence and playing a part with

Our Maths units this half term are:
- Multiplication and Division
- Area
We will have a continued focus on the times tables as all children are expected to know all 12 by the end of the year. Our KIRF this half term is: ***I know the x and ÷ facts for the 6x table.***

English

In English, we will be focusing on writing recounts and instructional texts, character descriptions and writing stories. We shall continue to develop our understanding of more complex sentence structures and the use of adventurous vocabulary

Our whole class reads are: How to Train a Dragon and The Boy who Grew Dragons.
