PSHE

Our PSHE unit is 'Keeping Safe'. We will explore different ways to keep ourselves safe and happy. We will think about everyday situations where we might need to think about safety. The children will think about what happens to their body when they feel nervous or worried.

RE

In RE we will be using the question 'What do Christians learn from stories of Jesus?' This unit explores how Jesus lived, highlighting that many of his experiences were the same as ours (human), whilst many others were exceptional.

Science

Our Science focus is Everyday Materials. The children will learn to distinguish between objects and the material from which it is made. They will identify a variety of materials including, metal, wood, plastic, glass, rock and water. The children will think about the properties of these materials.

Design and Technology

In Design and Technology we will be stitching a piece of bunting. The children will be exploring how fabrics are made and used and how to thread a needle and make stitches. They will then sketch a design for a piece of bunting before making it.

PE

In PE our units will be Core PE and Real Gym. For Core PE we will develop our dynamic balance: on a line, static balance and stance. For Real Gym we will focus on flight and balance. In both of these units we will be developing our cognitive skills.
Our PE days this half term are Tuesdays and Fridays.

Computing

In Computing we will be developing an understanding of commands and instructions in programming through unplugged activities.

History

This half term we will be focusing on 'How toys have changed'. In this unit, we will discuss our favourite toy using language from the past. We will ask questions and compare toys in the past and present. We will also sequence artefacts from different periods of time, identify changes between teddy bears today and from 100 years ago and describe how toys have changed over time.

Music

In Music the children will explore dynamics through the theme of the seaside. They will make links between music, sounds and environments and use percussion, vocal and body sounds to represent the seaside.

English

In English we will be focusing on writing character descriptions, persuasive letters and instruction writing.

Our whole class reads are:

- 'Beegu' by Alexis Deacon
- 'There's a Rang-tan in my Bedroom' by James Sellick
- 'Somebody Swallowed Stanley' by Sarah Roberts
- 'Splash' by Claire Cashmore

Maths

Our Maths units this half term are:
- Place Value within 20
- Addition and Subtraction within 20
