This week our activities were based on the **Tales from Acorn Wood** series. We enjoyed playing instruments like in *Badgers Band*. We learnt the names of instruments and counted them too. We worked on our comprehension skills and sequenced the illustrations from *Mole's Spectacles* and made macaroni and cheese from *Cat's Cookbook*. We even made get well cards for mouse from *Dormouse Has a Cold*. The highlight of the week was of course seeing many of the stories acted out at the Haymarket Theatre. In phonics this week we focused on reading words ending with s. In some cases, the s sounded more like a z for example bags, dogs, pins, rings... Our new tricky words were we, me and be.
