#### Class Update



This week our activities were **Winter** themed and we read the story *The Mitten* by Jan Brett. Before listening to the story we examined the cover of the book and made predictions. The children also learnt the term prediction. Luckily, we had snow this week which worked well with our theme!

We started Show and Tell this week which is a great way for children to share their interests but also a great way for them to build their oral language skills and confidence speaking in front of a group.

In phonics, we learnt the digraphs/trigraph ai, ee, igh and oa. The complexity of the digraphs and trigraphs are increasing. It was particularly difficult spelling words with the igh sound. Some of our new words this week include: rain, wait, tail, see, feet, meet, sheep, night, light, right, high, soap, coat, goat and boat. Thank you to the parent readers who came during the afternoons to listen to the children read.

In maths, we did a lesson on the concept of zero and worked on ordering numbers from 0 to 10.

Both our PE lessons this week worked on ball skills and controlling a ball with one or two hands. It was tricky! We also received some new outdoor play equipment to work on gross motor skills throughout the day. The children have really enjoyed it.
