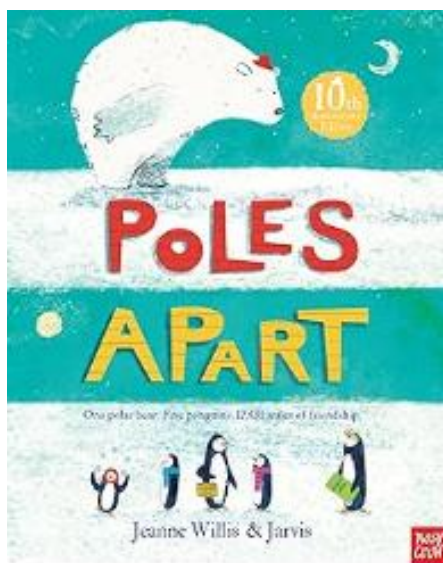

Class Update



This week our theme was **Antarctica** and we learnt a song about the seven continents. The children looked at a globe and maps and can now identify Antarctica. We learnt many facts about Antarctica and penguins. In literacy, we read *Poles Apart* which is all about a family of penguins who get lost and end up in the North Pole. Each child also enjoyed making a penguin to take home at the end of the week.

In phonics, we learnt the digraphs oo (moon), oo (book), ar, and or. Some of our new words this week include: moon, food, boot, foot, look, book, cook, car, dark, park, sort, torn, born and fork. We also had three new tricky words was, you and they. Thank you to the parent readers who came during the afternoons to listen to the children read.



In maths, we worked on subitising and representing numbers to 10 in different ways (fingers, dice, tens frame). We practised these skills with some fun penguin maths games.

In PE this week, one session focused on balls skills and progressed from last week and the other PE session was on dance. The children really liked time to freestyle and we also learnt some standing and floor dance positions.

In RE, our focus this half term is on special places including churches. The children had to reflect and draw their favourite place. We had fantastic answers like home, Grayswood School, the playground, the zoo, the aquarium, the beach, the ice cream shop...

The class also attended their first whole school assembly! We will carry on attending the Celebration Assemblies on Fridays until the end of the year. You will be invited to the assembly if your child is receiving an award. You will be notified the week before.
