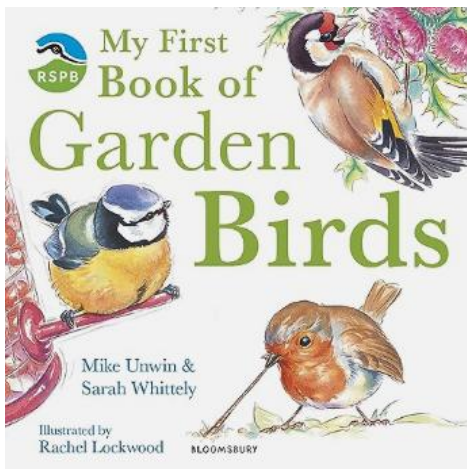

This week our theme was **British Birds**. We learnt about The Royal Society for the Protection of Birds (RSPB) and did some bird watching from our deck and playground. The children learnt the characteristics of some popular garden birds such as wrens, blue tits, robins, blackbirds and woodpigeons. We also had the fantastic opportunity to look at a bird's egg.

In phonics, we learnt the digraphs *ur*, *ow*, *oi* and the trigraph *ear*. Some of our new words this week include: fur, hurt, turn, now, down, cow, join, coins, soil, beard, fear, hear and near. We also had three new tricky words my, by and all. Thank you to the parent readers who came during the afternoons to listen to the children read. The children's blending and fluency is really coming along.



In maths, we consolidating the concept of 1 more and 1 less. We also worked on the different compositions of the number 5.



In PE this week, we carried on with our ball skills and dance. In RE, we discussed why Christians go to church.
