In English this week we have used the traditional story 'The Three Little Pigs' to inspire our next write. We started the week retelling the story through drama and then moved on to changing the characters and setting of the story. Towards the end of the week, we planned our own version of traditional tale. We used adjectives to describe the settings. Next week we will be writing our stories and sharing our results with Wrens.

In maths this week we continued the unit 'Place Value within 50'. We have been grouping tens and ones, partitioning tens and ones, using the number line to 50 and finding one more and less than numbers to 50. To support at home, you could play bingo with numbers up to 50 to encourage counting and recognising numbers.
