Class Update

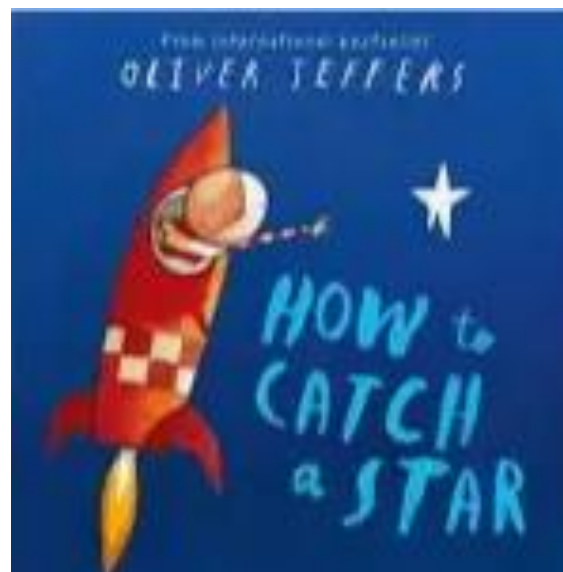
This week our theme was **Space**. We made junk model rockets and drew planets with chalk. We wrote sentences about the moon landing. We learnt lots of facts about space and read the story *How to Catch a Star*.



In phonics, we reviewed all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs. Please take time to read the phonics update in the Reading Records. This half term there will be no new sounds but we will learn to read longer and more complex words.

In maths, we continued learning about doubles and adding two numbers together.

In RE we read *The boy who Cried Wolf*. We are learning that stories can teach us how to behave. The children learnt from the boy that we should not tell lies.



Recently in music, we have been learning about tempo. The children understand that tempo means the speed of the music and that some music can be fast or slow. We have also been learning action songs.
