Class update

The highlight of the week has to be World Book Day. The children's costumes were fantastic! It was so lovely to see their efforts and celebrate reading for the day. We had a parade in the hall to start the day and enjoyed doing book related activities with extra story times throughout the day 😊



In English this week we began writing our own version of 'The Three Little Pigs'. We started by using time words; first, then and finally to describe what the animal's made their homes out of before moving on to describe the villain blowing down the two houses. We then wrote the ending to the story ensuring we used adjectives and expanded noun phrases. We shared our stories with the Wrens on Thursday which was a lovely way to celebrate them.

In maths this week we have begun the short unit –measure. We started by comparing lengths and heights using objects in the classroom. We then measured the length of objects using non-standard units of measure like multilink cubes and counters. We then moved on to using more formal units of measure – measuring length in centimetres. To support at home, you could ask your child to find something longer than a pencil but shorter than a ruler. You could then measure that object in cm.

The phonics we have been covering this week follows on from this Friday note. Please practise at home and sign your child's reading diary.

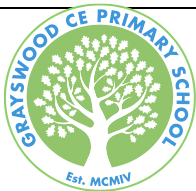
Spellings
