Class Update

This week our theme was **Spring**. We read *The Flower Thief* and learnt about the seasonal changes. We learnt the signs of spring and did a scavenger hunt.

In phonics, we reviewed all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs. Our focus this week was reading words with more than one digraph or trigraph. Some examples include: sharp, shark, sheep, queen, teeth, chain, powder, corner and farmer. We are learning to spell words with more than one digraph too. We also reviewed the tricky words no, of, to, into, she, he and we.

Next week we will complete the Spring 2 phonics assessment ahead of Parents' Evening so the results can be shared with you.

In maths, we starting learning about the passing of time and ordering and sequencing time. We also explored the composition of the numbers 9 and 10.



In RE we read *The Sharing Shell*. This story sparked a conversation about the importance of sharing.



In PE, we were practising different types of jumps and jumping from different heights.

Next week there will be two special events. We have an GB athlete coming to visit and there will be a special PE activity on Wednesday. We also have our British Wildlife workshop on Friday.
