This week we continued our **Spring** theme. We wrote sentences about what we can see in Spring.

In phonics, we reviewed all the phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs. Our focus this week was reading words ending with ing and compound words. Some examples include: looking, marching, cooking, waiting, morning, singing, chatting, farmyard, carpark and popcorn. We also reviewed the tricky words he, we, me, be, was, you, they and all.

This week we started completing the Spring 2 phonics assessment ahead of Parents' Evening so the results can be shared with you.

In maths, we explored numbers 9 and 10. We were also comparing numbers to 10.

In PE, we were practising different types of rolls this week. In Music, we added music to stories. We played different instruments to add effects to the story *We are Going on a Bear Hunt*. We took turns being the performers and the audience.



We had a fantastic workshop today about British Wildlife! We got to hold a toad and touch a snake. We also saw a baby hedgehog and a tawny owl! On top of seeing the animals we learnt about their diets, habitats and physical characteristics.
