A growing number of our pupils and staff members live with allergies, and it is important that all children develop awareness, empathy, and a sense of responsibility towards one another. These sessions will support pupils in understanding the importance of being mindful about food, sharing and following school guidance.

We hope this will be a valuable opportunity to build understanding and reinforce our shared commitment to ensuring a safe and inclusive environment for everyone.

### Class Update

This week our learning has been on animals around the world. We have discussed how some animals have adapted to live in certain environments and the class have produced some gorgeous animal print artwork.



In phonics we have been reading words containing more than one digraph e.g. shorter, thinker and powder. In our phonics lessons we have been writing key words from the lesson to practice segmenting for spelling.

In maths we have continued to explore the composition of the number 10 and the different ways 10 can be arranged. Some children challenged themselves by writing a number sentence to go with their work e.g.  $4 + 4 + 2 = 10$ . Over the week, the children have been counting to 20 and sequencing numbers in the correct order. Today we have been building on the children's concept of doubling and to know that this means 'twice as many'.

The whole school celebrated Earth Day on Wednesday and this linked in nicely with our RE, thinking about what fills us with awe and wonder in nature. The Wrens were busy looking at how they could repurpose recycling.
