Class Update

This week the Wrens have listened to the story of Goldilocks and the Three Bears. The class have enjoyed acting out and retelling the story using props, as well as building the three bears house using the magnatiles and designing a bed for baby bear.



In phonics we have been reading even longer words with consonant blends at the beginning and end of a word e.g. swift, squelch, and sprint. We have also introduced the tricky words: have, were, and says – please do keep practicing these 😊 .

This week in maths, the Wrens have built on their knowledge of simple AB patterns from the autumn term. We introduced more complex patterns such as ABC and ABCD, where all the elements are different. We've learnt how patterns can be audible as well as visual e.g. clap clap, stomp, stomp. We've applied our learning by trying to spot patterns in our environment and how we can often see patterns in fabrics and tried to spot the pattern on different wrapping paper.
