Welcome back after the half-term break. Year 6 have settled quickly and made a strong start to the final half-term. In English, the children have been drafting personal anecdotes, looking back over their Grayswood journey from Wrens to Kites. They also enjoyed a BBC free-writing stimulus, giving them space to write independently and creatively.



Our PSHE session, "I Look Great!", focused on confidence and positive self-image — the children approached the discussion with maturity. In Maths, we explored pi, using practical measuring to understand where the number comes from and proving it across many different examples. In Geography, the class began their independent fieldwork enquiry. They first developed their own enquiry questions and then considered which

data-collection methods would be most effective. We've also started learning songs for the Leavers' Assembly and our end-of-year play.
