This week we have continued our learning on dinosaurs and the class have been making their own salt dough fossils. We read the story of the Girl and the Dinosaur – it's a lovely book about a girl's wish coming true; the dinosaur bones she digs up on the beach come to life and take her on an adventure. This inspired wrens to write their own wishes.

In phonics we have been reading Phase 4 CVCC and CCVC words containing the phase 3 vowel digraphs and trigraphs, such as, toast, speech, and paint.

In maths, the class have been looking at addition number sentences using a 'first, then, now' structure to create mathematical stories. For example in the picture, we can say first there were 2 pigs, then 2 more joined and now we have 4 altogether.
