The class continue to excel in their phonics and we've been reading CCVCC words with long vowel sounds, for example; sprain, crown, fright, spoil.



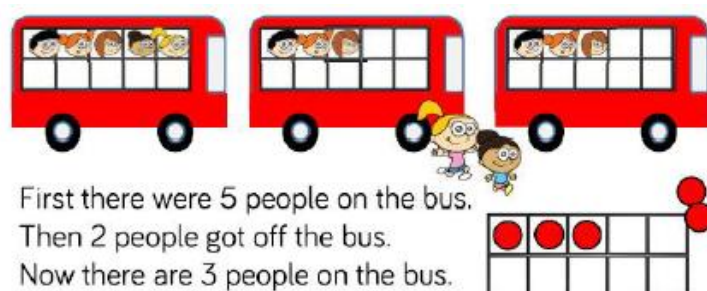

On the writing table the children have been writing lists of things they'd need to pack to take to the beach with them. This has provided lots of opportunity to practice writing phase 3 sounds, consonant blends and compound words; for example, sun cream.



In maths we have been using the first, then, now structure to understand the idea of subtraction/ taking away. The class understand that the quantity gets smaller if we take away. We have been using a tens frame to count out the initial amount, practically taking away and subitising how many are left.
