The week has seen the children working through their summer term assessments, each completing two papers in SPaG (Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar), Reading and Maths. We were able to get all of these done by Wednesday as the 30 Robins were in school, so thank you for ensuring their attendance. It is considerably easier administering such 'quizzes' in one hit, so that was a good way to start the week.

In English, the children wrote the end section of their story, retelling the tale of 'The Three Little Pigs' from the wolf's perspective. Once again, some of their description and phrasing was lovely and many of the children were keen to share their writing, by reading it out loud to the rest of the class.

The maths lessons that we have managed to deliver this week looked at Position and Direction. This is the final maths unit the children will cover this year, before a couple of consolidation weeks bring the term to a close. So far, they have looked at the language of position and begun to describe movement.

With the heatwave-induced early closing in effect from Tuesday, the afternoon foundation subjects have not taken place as they usually would, but will of course continue as normal from next week. Hopefully we can return to full-length school days and a normal timetable.
