Class Update



This week we have been learning all about pirates! There has been lots of brilliant role-play happening with lots of pirate talk, ships constructed from wooden blocks and creating of maps.



After reading the story *'The Pirates Next Door'*, Wrens have been creating their own pirate pictures and then writing a 'wanted' poster describing what they look like. We've had lots of hooks for hands and gold teeth!



In phonics this week we have been adding the suffix -ing to CCVC words such as creeping and groaning. We have also been adding the suffix -ed to root words, noticing that in some words it makes a 't' sound, for example in croaked and splashed. In other words it can make an 'id' sound like in floated and painted and in others the 'd' sound as in stormed and cleared.

The class had their transition afternoon this week, they spent the afternoon in the Year 1 classroom and had the opportunity to meet Mrs Chow. The children had a great afternoon and came back excited to tell us all about their new classroom.
