Class Update

Wow another busy week down and I can't quite believe we're heading into the final full week of term! We look forward to welcoming you into our classroom on Thursday afternoon. Please have a search around at home for any school reading books and send them back into school, as we need to sort these before September.

This week the children got the chance to spend the day on Wednesday with Mrs Burrell, who will be their Year 1 teacher on Monday-Wednesday.

In phonics we have been reading words with the suffix –er such as brighter and root words with the suffix –est such as smartest. Next week, we will be carrying out the last phonics assessment of the year. Please do keep practicing the phase 4 tricky words (in particular: do, there, says, little, what, out, here, one so, today) as they need to know these to move on to the next set of books.

This week in maths, we have been exploring rotating shapes. The children have been learning that a shape stays the same even when it is turned in a different direction. This is an important skill, as children can sometimes find it tricky to recognise familiar shapes, such as squares and triangles, when they are rotated. We have enjoyed using jigsaw puzzles and tangrams to practise turning and fitting shapes into different spaces.
